

## **SKGC Local Rules Effective April 9, 2011**

- Summer Rules
- Yellow lines and stakes mark Water Hazards. Red lines and stakes mark Lateral Hazards. White lines mark Ground Under Repair. White stakes indicate Out of Bounds. Interior edge of rock walls on right side of #1 and #3 indicate Out of Bounds. Construction fence behind 9<sup>th</sup> Green is out of bounds.
- Hole #1/10 – A ball deflected in the air by an inbounds utility pole, support wire or overhead wire *must* be replayed without penalty.
- The embedded ball rule is in effect.
- Stones in bunkers may be removed.
- Players are entitled to relief when their lie, stance or swing are obstructed by the following:
  - all cart paths: paved, gravel, item 4, natural, including run-off.
  - all areas marked in white designating ground under repair.
  - all tire tracks due to wet conditions and areas of damage due to course construction projects.
  - all yardage markers including remaining “150 yard bushes”.
  - decorative gardens areas including: Flag pole, commemorative marker, surrounding 2<sup>nd</sup> tee box, Hallys’ Park (including rock wall), bridge behind 3<sup>rd</sup> green, surrounding 8<sup>th</sup> tee.
  - all railroad ties, inbound telephone pole guide wires and stakes.
  - all drainage depressions through the green.
  - all electrical boxes.
- Players hitting their ball into the Lateral Hazard on holes #2, #4, and #6 are entitled to use the “optional Lateral Hazard Drop area” designated for each hole.
- Players striking their ball into the lateral hazard on the lower part of #7 thru the bi-colored stake (red and yellow “up the stream”) are entitled to utilize the drop area located in the rough on the fairway side of the bi-colored stake.
- **“Distance Measuring Devices:**

For all tournament-qualifying play, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a *stipulated round*, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.”

**Please make note of recent changes:**

- Green superintendents' parking area, storage shed and shop are Out of Bounds as marked by white stakes.
- Players are entitled to relief from "150 yard bushes".
- Players are not entitled to relief from "Pampas Grass" located behind 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> greens & along 5<sup>th</sup> tee.

*\*Players are encouraged to take a free drop from tee boxes during non-tournament and non-qualifying play.*
