

SPECIFIC MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

SINGLE: Full Time Single memberships are entitled to the full privileges of the club. This membership has one vote all elections. Must be at least 18 years of age.

CORPORATE: A corporate membership entitles you to use of the golf and restaurant facilities. In order to be included on a corporate membership, there must be evidence, preferably a current pay stub, which shows proof of employment. Corporate members will be afforded the privilege of unaccompanied guests Monday thru Friday with 24 hours notice to the clubhouse at a rate of \$35 per player. A corporate credit card must be kept on file to take advantage of this option. There are no guest restrictions if a member is present. Guests are the sole responsibility of the corporate member(s) while they are on property.

FAMILY: To qualify for a family membership, applicants must be married to one another. Children of family memberships must be 18 years old or under, or unmarried and attending college up to age 22. If a child in a family membership is not attending college, and is 18 years old on Jan 1, the child then becomes a single member for that year. If they turn 18 after Jan 1, they remain covered by the family membership for the remainder of the year. Children of family memberships cannot bring guests. Children in Family memberships cannot use carts unless 17 years old and have a NYS Driver's License.

JUNIOR: To qualify for a junior membership, applicant must be between 12 - 18 years old, or unmarried and attending college up to age 22. Junior members do not have to be the child of a member. If a junior member does not attend college, and is 18 years old on Jan 1, they are charged full member dues for that year. If they turn 18 after Jan 1, they remain covered by the junior membership for the remainder of the year. Junior members may not tee off before 2pm on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays unless accompanied by an adult member. Junior members do not have guest privileges. This membership is not subject to a monthly food assessment. Junior Members are not permitted to use carts.

RECENT GRAD: To qualify for a recent grad membership, applicant must be 26 years old or under when filling out application for current year membership. If applicant turns 26 after being accepted into the club, the recent grad rate holds for the remainder of the year. Applicant will automatically change to standard rate for the following year when age 27 is reached.

WEEKDAY: Weekday memberships are voting memberships. A weekday membership entitles you to use of the golf facilities during the week with the exception of league evenings (Tues/Wed). You are entitled to full use of the restaurant facilities and responsible for the monthly assessment. You are entitled to bring golf guests during the week only. Enter the guest's name in the Guest Book, located at the bar. You may play as a guest of a Full Time member on a weekend once/month. Register in the Guest Book, located at the bar. You may play in the Member/Member tournament only if all slots are not filled by Full Time Members. A guest fee of \$45 must be paid any tournament day before teeing off. If playing in the Member/Member tournament it is not counted as your play with a Full Time member for that month. You can play as a guest of a Full Time member on another weekend during that month.

First Responders (Police, Firemen, EMTs) & Military Personnel: Full Time Single memberships are entitled to the full privileges of the club. This membership has one vote all elections. Must be currently active and at least 18 years of age. 10 % of all memberships excluding Junior
